However, there would be inevitable disruption when items you brought in are suspicious, with mark-up or highlights, with notes, or are different in appearance compared to materials directly printed out from the government websites.	
8.	Can HKIA provide the PDFs of materials that can be allowed?	Please see below for a list compiled for candidate's REFERENCE. For laws, all PDF versions that can be downloaded from the e-legislation webpage are allowed. However, the "Assisted Monolingual PDF (English)" inside "PDF" under "Other Copy (with no legal status)" at the bottom of the scroll on the law's e-legislation page is recommended for simplicity and ease of reading.	
9.	Can I copy and paste the text from e-legislation webpages to my own file and print them out instead of downloading the PDF files from the e-legislation, Buildings Department's or Fire Services Department's webpages?	This is not recommended. The formatting and page numbers on your print- out using this cut and paste operation will vary, and invigilators will take a lot of time to carry out the checking. The interruption you may experience during assessment for this checking will very likely be longer than compared to other candidates who bring in "reference books" printed out from PDF versions of laws or code of practices directly downloaded from the e- legislation, Building Department or Fire Services Department websites.
