AN ENERGETIC HARBOURFRONT FOR THE COMMUNITY

- Create a harboufront for all where people can enjoy the stunning views, get active in the water, bathe in the sun, enjoy the sunset, or to meditate on the water.
- Design a facility along the harbour to provide support of water-related activities and recreation, and a place where the local community can enjoy the harbour.
- With reference to the Government Budget Plan, it could be a water park or sports facility at the old Wan Chai cargo basin, or a yoga/taichi garden, extreme sports facility or communal farm at the Tin Hai Promenade.

PROGRAMME

- Propose your own programme(s) to demonstrate your design vision!
- Demonstrate creative means to enhance the overall connectivity along the harbour promenade to the rest of the community.
- You may also propose any creative functions or events that provide recreational purpose for the general public.

Note: The proposal shall respect the Protection of the Harbour Ordinance, of which no reclamation or permanent structure shall be added beyond the seashore. (below, above or beyond...)

- You may choose any of the suggested location mentioned above (sites from the government harbour development plan) or,
- Propose any appropriate location along the Victoria Harbour to suit your proposal.
