# Urban Playspace for All

# DESIGN PROPOSAL

## THEME

### 1.0 BACKGROUND

To commemorate HKIA's accomplishments in serving our fellow architects as well as contributing to the society for 65 years, we take a step forward to connect with the community. With the anniversary theme "Architecture for People  $\lambda \lambda \equiv$ " HKIA aims to reiterate the humanity side of Architects and architecture, and to embrace the community with our designs and professionalism.

In response to "Architecture for People", how would our emerging young architects make a user-friendly place for all people? YAA2021 sets this challenge for you. How to resolve the conflicts between the need of COVID social distance and the role of communal space for social cohesion? Should your design serve as a prototype to facilitate the transformation of more inclusive places in Hong Kong?

#### 2.0 THEME

Over 50% of the world's population reside in cities, and by 2050, two out of three persons, of all ages, will share the urban space. Urban spaces are our shared asset to realize the betterment of high-density city living. How can cities offer better and happier playspace for people? How can we introduce innovative uses and new meanings for our public places in this COVID era?

Participants have to submit design proposal for Urban Playspace for All, which aims to showcase how playspace could be re-defined in our hyper-dense city; encourage the intergenerational interaction and play; and take advantage of the ambiguity of Hong Kong's architecture, such as radical mixed-use, indoor/outdoor, public/private while contributing more to the neighbourhood.

#### 3.0 PROGRAMME

Participants are to propose any programme(s), primarily entertainment/leisure related, to demonstrate his/her design vision.

#### 4.0 SCHEDULE OF ACCOMMODATION

Participant proposes a schedule of accommodation to suit his/her proposal.

#### 5.0 LOCATION

Participants are to propose any indoor and/or outdoor location(s) in the urban context to demonstrate his/her design vision.
