WINNING ENTRY

- HKIA Young Architect Award Trophy
- A 3-week Architectural Study Trip to the United States or one destination in Asia suggested in the architectural study proposal. The itinerary is
 - o to be proposed by the participant as part of the Submission Criteria; and
 - o to be coordinated by the Asian Cultural Council Hong Kong
- Winning design panel to be displayed at HKIA Premises and HKIA Annual Awards Exhibition
- Publication at HKIA Annual Awards Publication, HKIA Journal and other external media
- Besides the winning entry, other appropriate entry may be awarded a subsidy to execute a Career Development Plan proposed by the candidate, including a 12-month mentorship by past YAA recipient and/or senior member. The proposal shall be to be reviewed by the Organising Committee and proposed mentor subsequent to result announcement.

Countryside Renaissance

DESIGN PROPOSAL

THEME

1.0 BACKGROUND

Waves of village revival emerge recently in the countryside, from reviving agricultural landscape to cultural practices in Lai Chi Wo, Mui Tsz Lam and beyond. Subsequent to the mass migration of villagers to urban areas and overseas over the last century, rural areas now see a contemporary renaissance, providing an alternative lifestyle, cultural experience and recreational landscape that received a mass immigration of guests. Abandoned villages see a second life when villagers and volunteers rebuild their oblivion past and revive the culture and history.

2.0 THEME

What does countryside mean to urban dwellers of the modern metropolis in terms of history, lifestyle, architecture? What is the attractiveness of rural Hong Kong that fascinates urban dwellers? How does it inform the built environment that we architects build?

We invite participants to envision intervention with appropriate program in the countryside that respects the rich rural context, embraces nature and rethinks about the meaning of countryside conservation.

3.0 PROGRAMME

Participant can propose any programme(s), primarily cultural or leisure related, to demonstrate his/her design vision.

4.0 SCHEDULE OF ACCOMMODATION

Participant proposes a schedule of accommodation to suit his/her proposal.

5.0 LOCATION

Participant can propose any indoor and/or outdoor location(s) in the rural context to demonstrate his/her design vision.
