## **DESIGN BRIEF**

## 1.0 BACKGROUND

In recent years, there has been increasing interest raised by the general public on how heritage buildings should be conserved. King Yin Lei, being a subject of Government's intervention to preserve, is one of such examples.

Hong Kong is also known for its vibrant culture coexistence, a place where all kinds of people co-habitat in harmony. According to government statistics, there were about 350,000 non-ethnic Chinese staying in Hong Kong in 2006. This number is increasing as more people from other parts of the world come to seek opportunities. Different nationals become an integral part of Hong Kong society.

This competition aims to amalgamate these two debated topics and seek for ideas how heritage buildings could be re-examined and promote concordant co-existence amongst different ethnicities, discovering the depth and characteristics of minorities while establishing community resources.

## 2.0 THE SOLUTION

The proposal should be able to address the following issues:

- How a heritage building should be re-examined considering both preservation and revitalization?
- Should the preservation of a heritage building be merely a 'freeze of time'?
- What can be done to extend the life of a building so it can always be 'at the time'?

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
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
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
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
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
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









# LAYOUT PLAN PAVILION






LAYOUT PLAN (GROUND LEVEL)
