DESIGN BRIEF

1.0 BACKGROUND

The Hong Kong Institute of Architects [HKIA] encourages young architects to contribute their talent pro-actively in upholding the professional, art and cultural development of Hong Kong in a holistic manner. In response to this vision and mission, The Hong Kong Institute of Architects [HKIA] and Hong Kong Architecture Centre [HKAC] have collaborated to set the captioned theme for HKA Young Architect Award 2012 Design Competition.

2.0 THEME

朝行晚合 東遷西移 Versatility & Mobility

Architecture is one of the major forms of expression of the local culture: buildings from different generations reflect the changing core values of a community and represent the various stages of social development. Such unique qualities have made architecture the perfect tool to trace local cultural origin and identity. HKAC aims at creating new forms of interaction between the general public and local architecture.

The design competition asks for a design proposal of mobile units, which can be stationed at various districts to facilitate more intimate interactions between the architecture profession and the public on better understanding and appreciating local architecture on diverse occasions. For instance, the mobile units can act as "a movable architecture centre", propagandizing conservation of cultural heritage in Cheung Chau, exhibiting researches of urban studies in Mongkok, facilitating public consultations of urban redevelopment in Shamshuipo, and showcasing architectural award-winning proposals at Stanley Plaza, Sai Kung Waterfront Square, Shatin Town Hall Plaza or Tsim Sha Tsui Promenade. Participants are encouraged to suggest:

- Any creative means of interaction between the general public and local architecture, and
- Any creative functions or events in relation to the proposed mobile units.

The operation mode of the mobile units – "朝行晚合 東遷西移" signifies local wisdom that how prudent to make use of a tiny space to extend the possibility of event happenings in dense urban contexts; meanwhile, ease of erection, transportation and storage should also be considered.

3.0 PROGRAMME

The mobile units may accommodate the following functions:

- An exhibition gallery to promote Architecture of Hong Kong
- A learning centre
- A book / souvenir shop
- A café
- Ancillary facilities to support other events on promoting architecture appreciation as suggested by the participant

The mobile units are expected to be self-contained, secured, reasonably weather-proof and easy to be transported to different locations. They are able to be dismantled into pieces for storage.

4.0 SCHEDULE OF ACCOMMODATION

There are 4-6 modular units of total floor area 36 sq.m. Each unit is not larger than 3m wide x 3m depth x 3 m high. The participant can propose areas allocation for the above-mentioned functions to suit his/her proposal.

5.0 LOCATION

- Any outdoor venue(s) proposed by the participant
- The participant is expected to specify at least one location in Hong Kong to illustrate how the proposed mobile units respond to urban contexts.

6.0 ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

- Creativity
- Aesthetics
- Functionality
- Movability
- Sustainability
