NEIGHBOURHOOD SUSTAINABLE LIVING CENTRE IDEA COMPETITION

DESIGN BRIEF

1.0 BACKGROUND

The Environment Bureau of HKSAR issued "HK Blueprint for Sustainable Use of Resources 2013 – 2022". HK citizens are asked for to take more environmentally-sustainable actions in their daily lives towards a "Use Less, Waste Less" lifestyle. We should change our lifestyle fundamentally. Live in a simple way, avoid unnecessary consumption of natural resources, even though we are rich enough to pay the high financial and environmental costs. How can we trigger HK citizens' behavour change for sustainable living?

2.0 THEME

The idea competition asks for a design proposal of a Neighbourhood Sustainable Living Centre, which aims at facilitating the public to learn more about sustainable living knowledge, advocating the "Use Less, Waste Less" lifestyle, and developing neighbourhood networks of sustainable use of resources and recycling of wastes.

As an all-round young architect who can take this challenge to a new level, one has to establish the design vision and to propose key accommodation and programme as a full design package. The site selection is opened for suggestion by individual participants in order to best illustrate their design setting.

3.0 PROGRAMME

Participant proposes any programme(s) to demonstrate his/her design vision.

4.0 SCHEDULE OF ACCOMMODATION

Participant proposes a schedule of accommodation to suit his/her proposal.

5.0 LOCATION

Participant proposes any appropriate location to suit his/her proposal. It is encouraged that participants consider undesignated urban spaces such as spaces under flyover structures.

6.0 BRIEFING SESSION

Design Briefing Session will be held on 17 December 2013 at HKIA premises. Participant makes his/her decision to adopt any reference material presented at the briefing session.
