## IDEA COMPETITION

### DESIGN BRIEF

#### 1.0 BACKGROUND

In 2006, arts and culture are recognised as an essential part of any world-class city's economic and social fabric. "Four Pillars and Six Industries in Hong Kong" are proposed in 2009, which included cultural and creative industries. Venues provided to further develop cultural and creative industries needed to wait till 2019. To foster and nurture exceptional talents, venues are needed now for artists' interpretation, exhibition and performance. It is vital for introducing them to the general public. And yet the spatial design of exhibition is either traditional museum or alternative space. Are these spaces sufficient to satisfy the need of cultural and creative industries?

#### 2.0 THEME

What is (New)? What is the trend expressing art and creative design? In what way the art and creative design can interact, communicate and present to the audience? Is (New) solely about one channel, one disciplinary? How will you interpret (New)?

Participants have to submit Design Proposal for a "Hong Kong (New) Art Museum", which aim to provide space for the artists presenting their works, allow dialogue and interaction between artists and public and represent the identity of Hong Kong.

#### 3.0 PROGRAMME

Participant proposes any programme(s) to demonstrate his/her design vision.

#### 4.0 SCHEDULE OF ACCOMMODATION

Participant proposes a schedule of accommodation to suit his/her proposal.

#### 5.0 LOCATION

Participant proposes any appropriate location to suit his/her proposal. It is open to the participants consider undesignated urban spaces or revitalisation heritage.

#### 6.0 BRIEFING SESSION

Design Briefing Session will be held on 1 March 2017 at HKIA premises. Participant makes his/her decision to adopt any reference material presented at the briefing session.
