

# HOUSING<sup>+</sup> Reimagine Affordable Housing & Better Living

#### **IDEA COMPETITION**

#### **DESIGN BRIEF**

#### 1.0 BACKGROUND

The Future of Affordable Housing?

Nearly half of our population lives in either public housing or subsidised housing in Hong Kong<sup>1</sup>. With the aid of efficient modular construction and best utilization of our limited land supply, affordable housing provides shelters that benefit many to satisfy the basic need of living. It also creates communities scattered around our city with all forms of amenities to fulfil the community's needs.

As we enter a new decade, one may speculate what will our ideal future living be in the next decade and the decades to come? Will our public housing be able to cope with the changing lifestyles of the future generations? How will housing estate design adapt to the growing and shifting inter-generational demographics? How can we maintain a sustainable community?

As an architect, what is the value of architectural design as a contribution to the city dweller's well-being? Can architectural design serve to improve the quality of life, enhance a neighbourhood's livability, and foster a cohesive community?

#### 2.0 THEME

#### **HOUSING**<sup>+</sup>

The competition seeks for innovative and unique design proposal of a Housing<sup>+</sup> Community, breaking through existing framework in public housing design and demonstrate design creativity with forward-looking ideas.

Participant is to design a hybrid building, co-locating community facility(ies) of his/her choice (such as library, day care centre, urban farm, etc) with residential units.

The design of the residence should provide original and quality space that promotes sustainable living and well-being beyond a humble shelter, optimizing livability within the constraints of high-density dwellings in the Hong Kong scenario.

The design should enable the residents to form quality connections with the surrounding community and hypothesize the interrelations between the private realm of dwellings and the public spaces of the city.

Participant may also consider the use of innovative building materials and construction technologies such as MIC (Modular Integrated Construction) to enhance economic efficiency for these affordable housing.

#### 3.0 PROGRAMME

The design proposal should provide 250-300 residential units, with various sizes for single and multiple dwellers, versatile and adaptable to different users. A community facility should also be included in the proposal. The participant may also propose other suitable programmes, creative functions or events to demonstrate his/her design vision.

#### 4.0 SCHEDULE OF ACCOMMODATION

Participant proposes a schedule of accommodation to suit his/her proposal. The size of residential units and community space needs to be user-friendly, flexible in layout and encourage quality-living, while being realistic and practical in the urban scale of Hong Kong.

#### 5.0 LOCATION

Participant may propose any site in Hong Kong smaller than 2,000m<sup>2</sup> to suit his/her proposal. It is open to the participants to consider undesignated urban space, brownfield or revitalization of existing building
