Board of Practices (BP)

1.	Reply to DEVB on the Draft SOPL Bill	HKIA was consulted by DEVB on the draft Security of Payment Legislation (SOPL Bill). Four engagement meetings on the subject matter amongst corporate members were held from June to August 2022. HKIA agreed with the original intent of the SOPL in spirit and so would support the Draft Bill if the comments were duly addressed positively. The Board of Practices replied to DEVB on 6 Oct 2022.
2.	Communication meeting with DEVB, ArchSD and AAP	The 35th Communication meeting with DEVB, ArchSD and AAP would be held on 8 December 2022. VP Thomas Cheung, BP Chairman Paul Mui, BP Member Albert Chan and President-elect Benny Chan would attend the meeting.
3.	Formation of Task Force on Adjudicator Nominating Body (ANB)	HKIA was appointed as an ANB by DEVB. The Task Force on ANB was set up to follow up the ANB matters.
4.	Updating and printing of the CDR Handbook	The existing CDR Handbook has not been updated for more than 10 years. CDRC Committee is updating the handbook and would produce both electronic and printed version to Members for reference.
5.	Secretariat service to JDRC	BP is providing secretarial service to the Joint Dispute Resolution Committee jointly organized by HKIS and HKIA since 2 January 2022. As of 31 October 2022, 15 applications for appointment of arbitrators and 2 applications for appointment of mediators were received.
6.	BIM Pro Full Training Programme	BP prepared a tender proposal to engage a service provider to provide 35-40-hour BIM Pro Full Training Programme to members. Four tender proposals were received. The tender interviews took place in Nov 2022.
7.	BIM Pro Top-up Training Programme	The 6 th round of BIM Pro Top-up Training Programme would be held on 19 Nov 2022, 26 Nov 2022 and 10 Dec 2022.
8.	HKIA BIM Professional Certification	As of 31 October 2022, 170 applications were received. 132 application assessments were completed and 36 were under review by the assessment panel. The approved numbers of BIM Pros and BIM Cos were 80 and 11 respectively. Names of the approved members were uploaded on the HKIA website.
9.	HKIA Directory of Architectural Practices 2022	Corporate Members were invited to provide submissions for the HKIA Directory of Architectural Practices 2022 in Nov 2022. 350 printed copies in green paper with soy ink would be made and available for corporate members to collect in early Dec 2022. 10.	Guided tours on Exhibit Kai Tak Sports Park in the 25 Years of Design Exhibition	Two guided tours on Exhibit Kai Tak Sports Park followed by a lecture illustrating the advantages of digital construction and how BIM and advanced technology could support the planning and execution of Kai Tak Sports Park, in the 25 Years of Design Exhibition were held on 2 Sep 2022. About 50 members participated in the event. Positive feedback from the participants was received. HKIA Secretariat was discussing with the construction company to see if a construction site visit could be arranged for HKIA members.
11.	Construction site visit of Redevelopment of Mariner's Club	A construction site visit of Redevelopment of Mariner's Club co-organised by the HKIA and the Hong Kong Institute of Construction Managers was held on 17 Sep 2022 at 11 Middle Road, Tsim Sha Tsui. About 50 members attended the visit.
12.	Breakfast Meetings with Bands 1, 2 and 3	Two breakfast meetings with Band 1 and Bands 2 and 3 were held on 4 Jul 2022 and 12 Aug 2022 respectively. An additional breakfast meeting with Band 1 was held on 30 Nov 2022.

Eco Expo Tour 2022	Invited by Hong Kong Trade Development Council, HKIA was given a 3x3m booth to showcase Registered Practices' works related to the theme " Green Innovations for Carbon Neutrality " at the Eco Expo at Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre from 14 to 17 Dec 2022. A Taskforce composed of Environment and Sustainable Development Committee (E&SDC) and BP was formed to handle the exhibition booth.
