My Mission

- I commit to **curate a better City and Society** through going **into the Community**:
 - organizing volunteering works for the less privileged groups.
 - i. I led a group of dedicated architects under the COVID-19 Task Force to conduct outreach programmes to help checking the health and hygiene conditions of Elderly Homes, Special Care Homes, Primary and Secondary Schools, and handing over anti-epidemic packs to families living in sub-divided flats.
 - ii. Recently I curate the programme to call for donation of computers to needy students to support the forthcoming new norm of learning at home.
