Ms. Jacqueline Lee joined the Architectural Services Department in 2007. Her design projects have gained both local and regional awards for achievements in architectural value and sustainability. Throughout the years, she was exposed to public affairs including LegCo, District Councils, Harbourfront Commission with the engagement of different stakeholders. She has also worked with renowned architectural practices, building professionals and scholars in various kinds of institutional projects and studies.

Ms. Lee was seconded to the Civil Engineering Development Department from 2019 to 2022 to provide architectural advice on Kai Tak Development and infrastructure works. One of her key roles is to lead the design and implementation of public open spaces and promenades in private developments in the Former Runway with collaboration with private developers. She has also been involved in the urban review study of Kai Tak Development which provided her valuable exposure to the Harbourfront Commission and planning consultations. She learnt the importance of urban planning in a city with considerations to infrastructure, livability, sustainability, carbon neutrality, bio-diversity, inclusive city and smart initiatives. With the vision of new town planning in Hong Kong such as Northern Metropolis and the Lantau Tomorrow, she believes that local architects should continue to gear up to shoulder our important roles in urban planning.

With the challenges the local building industry facing ahead, Ms. Lee realizes the importance of collaboration of multi-disciplinary professionals which is being continuously developed worldwide.
