This CIC Construction Innovation Award (CICCIA) aims to recognise outstanding innovators in construction who are driving the transformation of the Hong Kong construction industry in the three key areas: productivity, sustainability and safety in construction projects.

There are two categories of the Award: **International Awards** and **Local Awards**.

There are 3 prizes in **International Awards**: (1) Grand, (2) 1<sup>st</sup> Prize and (3) 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize.
