1.	HKIA's COVID-19 Survey	BP issued an online survey to collect the information from Registered Practices (RPs) about their practicing situation during the current COVID-19 on 29 Apr 2020.
2.	Anti-epidemic Fund	HKIA issued a letter to Development Bureau (DEVB) and had the subsequent meeting with DEVB and the representatives from Architectural Services Department (ArchSD), Buildings Department (BD), Lands Department (LD) & the Construction Industry Council (CIC) on 5 Mar 2020, through the coordination by Hon. Tony TSE. DEVB replied HKIA dated 6 Apr 2020 that the coverage of the Anti-epidemic Fund has been extended to all of HKIA RPs including small and medium firms in addition to those under the Architectural and Associated Consultants Selection Board (AACSB) list in the first round funding. Eligible firms would be granted an amount of HK\$20,000.
3.	BIM & IT	Meeting with Autodesk A Zoom meeting with Autodesk was held on 27 Apr 2020 to reflect members' grave concern on the New Revit Subscription Plan and Retiring of Existing Plan.  Construction Innovation and Technology Fund (CITF) Briefing A CITF Briefing via Zoom by CIC was held on 19 May 2020. 57 members and RP representatives joined the briefing.
4.	HKIA BIM Accreditation	A sum of 45 applications for BIM Pro and BIM Co were received. Among the applications, 29 applications were endorsed while the 16 applications were under reviewed by the assessment panels. Outreach to 4 secondary schools, on 16 May 2020  For preparation of school resume on 27 May 2020, 18 architect volunteers formed 4 teams to conduct school inspection for check-ups of crucial activity areas for hygiene and safety concerns.  2 outreaches are under preparation for primary school resume on 8 Jun 2020 and to assist families of sub-divided flat in Tsuen Wan to apply for financial assistance of CLP Power Connect Programme.  The Institute received 8,000 facial masks for adult from the Hong Kong Chinese Importers' & Exporters' Association. While the Institute is arranging to pass the masks to people in need via various NGOs, HKIA Council Members made matching donation in the account of HK\$31,000 as a token of support to the society. The donation will be used for the purchase of supermarket coupons, meal vouchers or kids' facial masks for people in need and the underprivileged families.
