Mutual Recognition of Accreditation Systems of Architectural Programmes between The Hong Kong Institute of Architects (HKIA) and New Zealand Registered Architects Board (NZRAB)

The HKIA and NZRAB have signed the Memorandum of Understanding of Mutual Recognition of Accreditation Systems of Architectural Programmes which is effective for five years from 3rd October 2012 until further renewal.

As a result of the mutual recognition of the respective accreditation procedures, both parties agree that :


1. The courses or programmes of study in architecture accredited by the HKIA shall be accepted as meeting the professional academic qualification requirement for registration as an Architect by the NZRAB; and
2. The courses or programmes of study in architecture in New Zealand accredited and listed by the NZRAB shall be accepted as meeting the professional academic qualification requirement for membership of the HKIA.

Graduates from the courses or programmes of study in architecture in New Zealand accredited fulfill the academic qualification requirement for sitting the HKIA/ARB Professional Assessment. The list of architectural programmes in New Zealand accredited is as follows.

University of Auckland – B Arch, M Arch (Prof)
Unitec Auckland – B Arch, M Arch (Prof)
Victoria University of Wellington – B Arch, M Arch (Prof)
